## Application Guidelines 2025 Rissho University Japanese-Language Program Semester Course

The Rissho University Japanese-Language Program Semester Course accepts short-term (up to one year in principle) international students, mainly from overseas partner universities and institutions. This special program enables participants to study the Japanese language, Japanese current affairs and Japanese culture in Japanese. Participants will also be able to take some classes conducted in Japanese at the various faculties of Rissho University depending on their Japanese language abilities.

It is our hope that participants in this program will interact with not only the students and staff of Rissho University but also the people of Japan while deepening their understanding of Japan and becoming active individuals in contemporary international society.

#### 1. Eligible Applicants (\*Eligible individuals must satisfy the following three conditions)

(1) a. Exchange students who are recommended by the heads of their home institutions with which Rissho University has academic and educational exchange agreements, and who are required to obtain credits at Rissho University as short-term international students.

b. Overseas students exceptionally admitted to Rissho University as short-term international students at the recommendation of the heads of their home institutions when Rissho University has an academic and educational exchange agreement with said institutions.

c. Overseas students exceptionally admitted to Rissho University as short-term international students at the recommendation of the heads of their home institutions when Rissho University does not have an academic and educational exchange agreement with said institutions.

- (2) Students who have passed the N2 level of the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test or who possess equivalent Japanese-language abilities.
- (3) Students who have never participated in the Rissho University Japanese-Language Program Semester Course.

### 2. Enrollment Limit

### 7 Students (Male: 2 students, Female: 5 students)

The capacity for males and females in the student dormitory may vary depending on the number of rooms. The figures provided are based on the previous term's actual numbers. Since the current capacity has not yet been confirmed, we will inform you promptly once it is finalized. If the number of applicants exceeds the dormitory's capacity, a document screening process will be conducted.

### 3. Course Duration

(1) Autumn Semester 2025

Semester : October 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026 (Term of Classes : Early October, 2025- Mid January, 2026)

(2) Full Academic Year (Autumn Semester 2025 and Spring Semester 2026)

Semesters : October 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026 and April 1, 2026 - September 30, 2026 (Term of Classes : Early October, 2025 - Mid July, 2026)

### 5. Curriculum

(1) Compulsory Subjects

### <u>Autumn Semester</u>:

Japanese Current Affairs III (22.75 hours), Japanese Current Affairs IV (22.75 hours), Japanese VI (45.5 hours), Japanese VII (45.5 hours), Japanese VIII (45.5 hours), Japanese IX (45.5 hours), Japanese X (45.5 hours)

Spring Semester:

Japanese Current Affairs I (22.75 hours), Japanese Current Affairs II (22.75 hours), Japanese I (45.5 hours), Japanese II(45.5 hours), Japanese IV (45.5 hours), Japanese V (45.5 hours)<u>Spring Semester</u>:

\*Class time was changed from 90 minutes to 105 minutes in April 2025.

\*The classes aim to enable students to pass the N1 level of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) for each semester.

(2) Optional Subjects (for those who are interested)

(An additional fee of 20,000 yen per subject is required.)

Students taking the full-year course can, depending on their Japanese language abilities, take classes in each faculty of Rissho University during the second semester with the permission of the faculty in question.

### (3) Place

Kumagaya Campus (Saitama Prefecture, about 35 miles from Tokyo/ about 2 hours by train

and bus)

### 6. Evaluation

After completion of the course, an academic transcript specifying each subject's title, grade awarded and credits acquired will be issued.

# 7. Certificate of Completion

Students who have acquired 14 credits (Compulsory Subjects) or more in a semester or 28 credits (Compulsory Subjects) or more in an academic year will receive a Certificate of Completion.

# 8. Tuition Fees

(1) 160,000 yen / semester

## \* Price Revision from the Spring Semester of 2025

(2) Payment deadline
<u>Autumn Semester 2025</u>: September 30, 2025
<u>Spring Semester 2026</u>: April 15, 2026
Students who attend for the full academic year must pay the fee for each semester.

### (3) Optional subjects

For students enrolled in the full-year course of the program who elect to take regular classes in any of the faculties of Rissho University during the second semester, the fee is 20,000 yen per subject. Students recommended by an institution with which Rissho University has a mutual tuition waiver arrangement are exempt from paying the tuition fees for regular classes in the spring semester (up to 6 credits or 3 subjects).

# 9. Insurance

[Japanese National Health Insurance]

Students are required to enroll in the Japanese National Health Insurance program. Students who have National Health Insurance basically pay 30% of the total medical fees payable when receiving treatment at clinics and hospitals.

# [Overseas Travel Insurance]

Before leaving their home countries, students are required to be insured with overseas travel insurance (study abroad insurance).

# 10. Accommodation (Dormitory)

The dormitory on Kumagaya Campus is available to students of this program. The particulars of the dormitory are outlined below.

(1) Room Type

Single room with bathtub, shower and toilet, air conditioning and mini-kitchen (No cooking permitted)

(2) Furniture/Fixtures

Desk, chair, bed, refrigerator, cabinet and shoe cabinet

(3) Common Utilities

Washing machine, dryer and microwave oven

#### (4) Other

Cafeteria, study room, and PC room

#### (5) Fees

1 Accommodation Fee : 35,000 yen / semester

\* The above includes residence insurance fee (5,000yen) and water fee.

- ② Fee for Bedding Supplies : approximately 10,000 yen
- ③ Room Cleaning Fee upon departure : approximately 15,000 yen
- ④ Electricity : from 5,000 to 15,000 yen/ month (depending on the amount used)
- \*(2) and (3) must be paid when moving into the dormitory.

#### \* Additional costs for food, transportation, textbooks, and personal spending, etc are necessary.

(6) Scheduled move-out date

- ① Six-month program : Mid February, 2026
- 0 Full academic year program: Late July, 2026

Spring Semester 2026 : April 15, 2026

When it is determined that everything is filled out correctly, we will ask you to resend the documents to us via EMS.
