Cancellation is available only by July 5, 2019.

#### \*Selection Criteria:

The assessment of each applicant will be based on the information provided on the application form plus the other required materials submitted as part of the application, and evidence of relevant experience and interest. Applicants will be selected based on the following criteria:

- (1) Relevance of training and research experience relevant to the topic of the workshops,
- (2) Working in a field or on research projects relevant to a workshop topic (including doctoral students whose dissertation research directly relates to a workshop topic),
- (3) Experience/ability using one or more statistical package (e.g. R, SAS, STATA, and SPSS)
- (4) Basis of their potential contribution to the workshops and to future professional work

**\*Others:**

- (1) The workshops will be held at three venues in different cities in the Republic of Korea, and applicants are able to select one, two, or all three workshops.
- (2) Limited funding for meals and lodging is available for full-time graduate students. For more information, please see the page 5, 'Meals and Lodging Provision for Graduate Student'.
- (3) A certificate of completion under the name of KOSTAT and UNFPA will be given to participants who successfully complete each workshop.

► **For Overseas Participants**

- \* The main airport in Korea is **Incheon International Airport**. If you fly from abroad to participate in the workshop, you can travel from Incheon International Airport to other cities by train or bus.
- \* If you plan to participate in Workshops 2 and 3, the airport for your arrival to Korea can be Busan (Gimhae) International Airport, instead of Incheon International Airport with a multiple destination reservation ('open-jaw' tickets).

► **Expenses to be covered by participants while attending the workshops.**

Tuition is supported by KOSTAT, but all prospective Summer Seminar participants are responsible for their own travel expenses incurred traveling to/from Korea such as airfare, meals, and lodging. All prospective applicants are advised to seek funding from their home organizations or from national or international agencies.

- (1) Round-trip airfare to/from Korea.
- (2) Expenses for accommodation and meals during the workshops (including weekends)
- (3) Expenses for all intercity transportation (buses or trains) from/to the workshop venue such as bus fares from the international airport to the workshop venue.

## The 6<sup>th</sup> KOSTAT-UNFPA Summer Seminar on Population Meals and Lodging Provision for Graduate Students

### ► Meals and lodging provision for graduate students

Meals and lodging provision for each workshop period will be given for a limited number of full-time graduate students on a selected basis. To apply for meals and boarding provision, please submit the 'Meals & Lodging Application Form' and your 'Official certificate of enrollment at current graduate school' to [popstat2019@gmail.com](mailto:popstat2019@gmail.com). The certificate of enrollment should be issued within last three months and contain an authorized confirmation (stamp or signature), and proof of enrollment during the workshop period (A student ID card is not accepted).

Please find the information below regarding travel expenses while attending the workshops.

### ► Schedule for meals and boarding provision for selected graduate students

- \* The meals and lodging provision cover expenses from Monday to Friday, only during the workshop.
  - Boarding provisions are based on double-occupancy. Two persons will share a room for 5 nights (Check-in: Sunday that is one day before the workshop begins, Check-out: Friday that is the last day of workshop).
  - Expenses for meals: KRW 20,000 (around \$18) per day up to 5 days for each workshop
- \* The half-day field trip on the weekend for each workshop will be offered by KOSTAT but meals and boarding provision will not be provided for every weekend.

### ► Basis for selection (meals and lodging provision for graduate students)

- (1) Priority will be given to doctoral students.
- (2) Those who have training experience or major in a relevant topic of the workshops are preferred.
- (3) Relevance research/work experience to the selected workshop(s) based on the information on the meals and lodging application form (if necessary)

### ► Notice

- (1) The organizers do not support transportation, including airfare. It is only for meals and lodging provision for each workshop period.
- (2) This provision will be given for a limited number of full-time graduate students for each workshop. Each applicant is responsible for all the expenses for weekends.
- (4) If you are not able to participate in the workshop(s), you should inform us at least two weeks before the beginning of the first workshop. In case of late cancellation or no show, penalties will be applied for future workshop application.
- (5) Both your 'Meals & Lodging Application Form' and 'Official Certificate of Enrollment' should be sent by email ([popstat2019@gmail.com](mailto:popstat2019@gmail.com)). Incomplete applications will not be considered. Acceptance letters will be sent out by 25 June, 2019.
